

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
OF MEASURE TO FORM STONYFORD RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT

A determination has been made by the Colusa County Board of Supervisors that there is need for the formation of a recreation district within the territory of portions of Colusa County and Glenn County.

The Board of Supervisors has called this Election to form a separate entity for this purpose, under the Recreation and Park Districts Law, Chapter 4 (Commencing at Section 5780) of Division 5 of the Public Resources Code, to be called the Stonyford Recreation and Park District. The boundaries of the District are to be as shown on the attached map, Exhibit "A" and consisting generally of boundaries that are the line between Colusa County and Lake County on the south and west; the northern line of T14N R5W on the south; the approximate mid-line of T15N R5W, T16N R5W and T17N R5W on the east; and the boundaries of the Indian Valley Fire District in Glenn County on the north, northeast and northwest.

The Stonyford Recreation and Park District if established, would levy an annual assessment for five (5) years commencing with the 1985-86 fiscal year according to the following schedule:

For each Residence upon a parcel of land containing 60 acres or less: \$15.00 per year;

For each Residence upon a parcel of land containing 61 acres or more: \$12.00 plus five cents (\$0.05) per acre per year;

For each parcel of land upon which there is no Residence: \$3.00 or five cents (\$0.05) per acre, whichever sum is the greater, per year.

and, after five (5) years, an assessment equal to one half (1/2) the foregoing rates, all said assessments to be collected along with County taxes.

Also there could be established an annual Appropriation Limit of \$10,000.00.

A "YES" vote on Measure A is a vote to form the District.

A "NO" vote on Measure A is a vote to deny formation of the District.


A "YES" vote on Measure B is a vote to establish an annual appropriation limit of \$10,000.00.

A "NO" vote on Measure B would be to deny the appropriation.

A "YES" vote on Measure C is a vote to levy an annual assessment for five years commencing with the 1985-86 fiscal year as set forth above.

A "NO" vote on Measure C is a vote to deny annual assessment.
