


Secondhand Smoke Exposure in Colusa County Apartments



In a recent survey of Colusa County apartment residents

- 93% agreed **secondhand** smoke has **harmful** effects to their health.
- 84% would be **in favor** of a law that requires some units in a building to be **non-smoking**.
- 86% would **prefer** to live in a completely **non-smoking building**.

There is **no safe level** of **secondhand smoke exposure**

Secondhand smoke can travel within apartments and common areas through doorways, cracks in walls, electrical lines, ventilation systems and plumbing.¹

Opening windows and using fans does not completely remove secondhand smoke.¹

Heating, air conditioning and ventilation systems cannot eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke.¹
