Colusa County Announces COVID-19 Webpage Refresh

Digital Resource Provides Weekly Vaccine Dashboard and Local Virus Data

(COLUSA, CA) February 8, 2021 - Today, the Colusa County Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) announced the launch of a refreshed webpage dedicated to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) response in Colusa County. The COVID-19 webpage includes a vaccine dashboard outlining doses received, doses distributed to health care partners, and doses administered directly by DHHS, as well as local virus data showcasing the status of the virus in our community. The COVID-19 webpage is updated each Monday afternoon, and is accessible in both English and Spanish.

“We understand that the vaccine plan and distribution process is confusing, and we are working to provide resources to clearly communicate our local plan, and provide information as we receive it,” stated Elizabeth Kelly, DHHS Director.

Colusa County is currently in Phase 1B of the State’s Vaccination Plan, which includes the following individuals and occupational categories:

- Persons aged 65 and older
- Persons aged 16-64 with medical conditions that increase COVID-19 risk
- Healthcare personnel not included in Phase 1A
- Law enforcement personnel
- Food packing and distribution centers
- Agriculture, manufacturing, and grocery workers
- Teachers, school staff, and childcare providers
- Those at high risk for severe illness with underlying health conditions
- U.S. Postal Service workers
- Public Transit workers

Residents are encouraged to contact their personal health care provider for next steps or to make a vaccine appointment. Colusa County is distributing the vaccine to our health care partners as we receive it.

DHHS will be establishing occupational clinics as vaccine is received from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Currently, Colusa County receives on average 200 doses every 10-days. In addition, CDPH is in the process of rolling out the My Turn vaccination eligibility and reservation system across the state. DHHS is working closely with CDPH on utilizing the system locally once it is officially available, and our local vaccine allocation supports a wider distribution.
