## NOTICE OF DISTRICT ELECTIONS AND ELECTIVE OFFICES TO BE FILLED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Governing Board Elections will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 in the District named below for the purpose of electing members to the following Board of Directors:

### STONYFORD RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT

**Number to be elected:** 5

**Term of Office:** 2 seats, four-year terms\*  
3 seats, two-year terms

**Qualifications:** Registered voter of the district

Candidate filing period opens on July 12, 2021 and closes on August 6, 2021 at 5:00 p.m., however, if an incumbent officeholder does not file by August 6th, at 5:00p.m., an extended filing period will begin. The extended filing period, if applicable, is not open to the incumbent officeholder, and is open to any other qualified candidate and shall have until 5:00p.m. on August 11<sup>th</sup> to file a Declaration of Candidacy and other related filing forms. The extended filing period does not apply if there are no incumbent officeholders.\* Official Declarations of Candidacy (forms) may be obtained and filed at the office of the Colusa County Clerk located in the Hall of Records at 546 Jay Street, Suite 200, Colusa, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The office hours are extended to 5 p.m. on deadline dates. In the event there are no nominees, or an insufficient number of nominees for an office, the office may be filled by appointment, unless a petition requesting an election is filed by voters of the District, pursuant to Elections Code 10515. \*There are no incumbent officeholders for the 2 four-year seats. These seats will not go into an extended filing period.
