## **GUBERNATORIAL RECALL ELECTION BALLOTS ARRIVING IN COLUSA COUNTY**

*Voting Options Include Mail-In or Visiting Designated Polling Places on Election Day*

**(COLUSA, CA) August 19, 2021** – The Gubernatorial Recall Election is Tuesday, September 14, 2021. Colusa County voters will begin receiving their official ballots in the mail this week. For this election, every active registered voter in Colusa County will receive a ballot in the mail. Colusa County is a “Traditional Polling Place” county, meaning in-person voting locations will be open on Election Day from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Voters choosing to vote in-person should go to their designated polling place on Election Day.

“In-person voters will also need to bring in their unvoted mail ballot to exchange it for a polling place ballot” said Rose Gallo-Vasquez, Colusa County Clerk-Recorder Registrar of Voters. “Voters voting by mail are encouraged to return their voted ballots early to ensure it is received on time. If mailing your ballot back, be sure it is postmarked by September 14, 2021.”
