Dear Voter,

Page 06-508, SECTION 2 18C-16. of the Colusa County Voter Information Guide and Sample Ballot book that was mailed to you, incorrectly states the proposed Measure A transactions and use tax ordinance has a "TERMINATION DATE." This section was printed in error.

The following text was not part of the final version adopted by the Colusa County Board of Supervisors and was printed in the County Voter Information Guide & Sample Ballot book in error.

~~18C-16. TERMINATION DATE. The authority to levy the tax imposed by this ordinance shall expire on the tenth anniversary of the effective date.~~

The following sections have been renumbered to reflect the removal of the erroneous text shown above and replaces the text that was printed in your guide.

18C-16. ~~18C-17.~~ RECEIPT OF PROCEEDS. All revenue generated by this ordinance shall be deposited in a special fund, used solely for the identified projects as provided herein, and made available to the County and to the agencies responsible for implementing the projects set forth in the expenditure plan in Section 18C-17.

18C-17. ~~18C-18.~~ EXPENDITURE PLAN.

A. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a local funding source for emergency medical ground transportation services and programs. The Board of Supervisors shall be responsible for reviewing and approving projects and programs that establish or enhance the availability of emergency medical ground transportation services within the County of Colusa.

B. Use of Revenues: The revenues generated pursuant to this ordinance, after deduction of the required California Department of Tax and Fee Administration costs for administering and collecting the tax, costs of the citizen advisory committee, and costs for services provided by the Colusa County Auditor-Controller, including costs of any required audits by the County Auditor-Controller, shall be used to fund projects or programs that provide or enhance emergency medical ground transportation services within the county.

18C-18 ~~18C-19~~ CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE. No later than March 1, 2023, the Board of Supervisors shall establish, by resolution, a Citizen's Advisory Committee. The resolution shall set forth the number of members, their term of office, and the selection process for the committee.
